

2020 Secondary Academic Scholarship

INFORMATION

Northside Christian College offers the following Academic Scholarships;

- **2019 Yr 6 and Yr 9 Students:** Scholarships of three-year tenure
- **2019 Yr 7, Yr 8, Yr 10 and Yr 11 Students:** Scholarships of one-year tenure

Both classes of scholarship attract a fifty-percent reduction in tuition fees.

1. Scholarship Application

a) Scholarship Application Form

The following must be submitted when applying for a scholarship:

- Photocopy of demonstrated certificates and awards of excellence
- Photocopy of the student's last school report and NAPLAN results
- Photocopy of student's Birth Certificate/Passport (only for new students)
- Completed Academic Scholarship Application form with payment

b) Application Fee

A \$100 non-refundable Academic Scholarship Application fee must be paid to Northside Christian College when the Academic Scholarship Application form is submitted.

The Academic Scholarship Applications close on **Friday 20th September 2019 at 4:00pm.**

Academic Scholarship Applications are open to all new and current students in Years 6 to 11 in 2019. Students may reapply in following years when a new fee will be applied.

2. Scholarship Exam – Thursday 17th October 2019

The Scholarship Exam will be held on **Thursday 17th October 2019** at Northside Christian College, 31 McLeans Rd, Bundoora. Please note that the Scholarship Exam date is not able to be rescheduled for individuals. Registration will be at **8.30am** in the College foyer and the exam will begin at 8.45am. The exams will incorporate testing of the following areas:

1. General reasoning (verbal and non-verbal)
2. Mathematics
3. Reading comprehension
4. Spelling
5. Written expression

3. Scholarship Exam Results & Interviews

High achieving candidates will be short listed and invited for an Interview with the Principal. These Interviews will take place on **Thursday 7th and Friday 8th November 2019.**

Please note that an invitation to an interview following the exam should not be taken as meaning that the candidate will be offered a scholarship. An offer will be made to the most eligible applicants.

4. Awarding of Scholarships

Awarding of the scholarships will be announced shortly after the interview, by letter. Successful candidates who are new to the College must then complete the normal enrolment process if they have not done so already.
